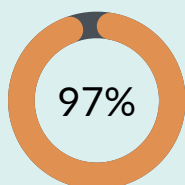
## RESULTS OF THE HCA 2021 COMMUNITY IMPACT SURVEY

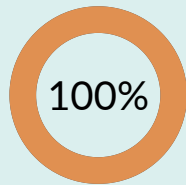
### YOU FOUND INFORMATION THAT WAS RELEVANT TO YOUR EVERYDAY PRACTICE.



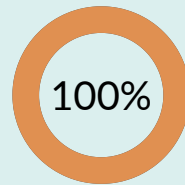
of you were **sometimes** or **often** able to find information relating to postsecondary mental health and addiction through HCA

of you **agree** or **strongly agree** that HCA contributed to the engagement of student care in the past year

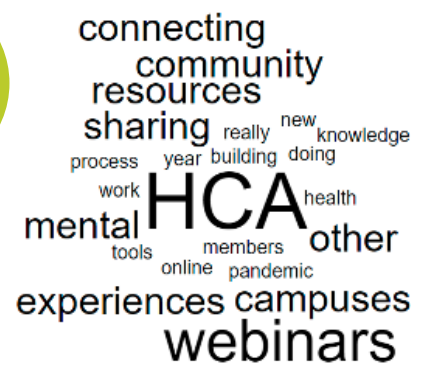


of you **agree** or **strongly agree** that HCA increased awareness about campus initiatives across Alberta in the past year

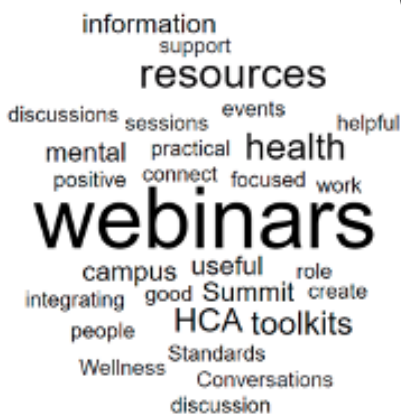

"The most meaningful aspect is to see what is already being done elsewhere and learn from it, and not re-invent the wheel."

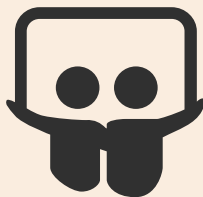
"I believe in the work HCA is doing, and when I could connect with staff it has been a lovely experience."

### YOU BUILT STRONG RELATIONSHIPS WITH A COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE

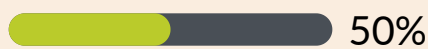
comprised of members across all 26 publicly funded Alberta postsecondary institutions and 5 First Nations colleges, Alberta Health Services, and community organizations.
