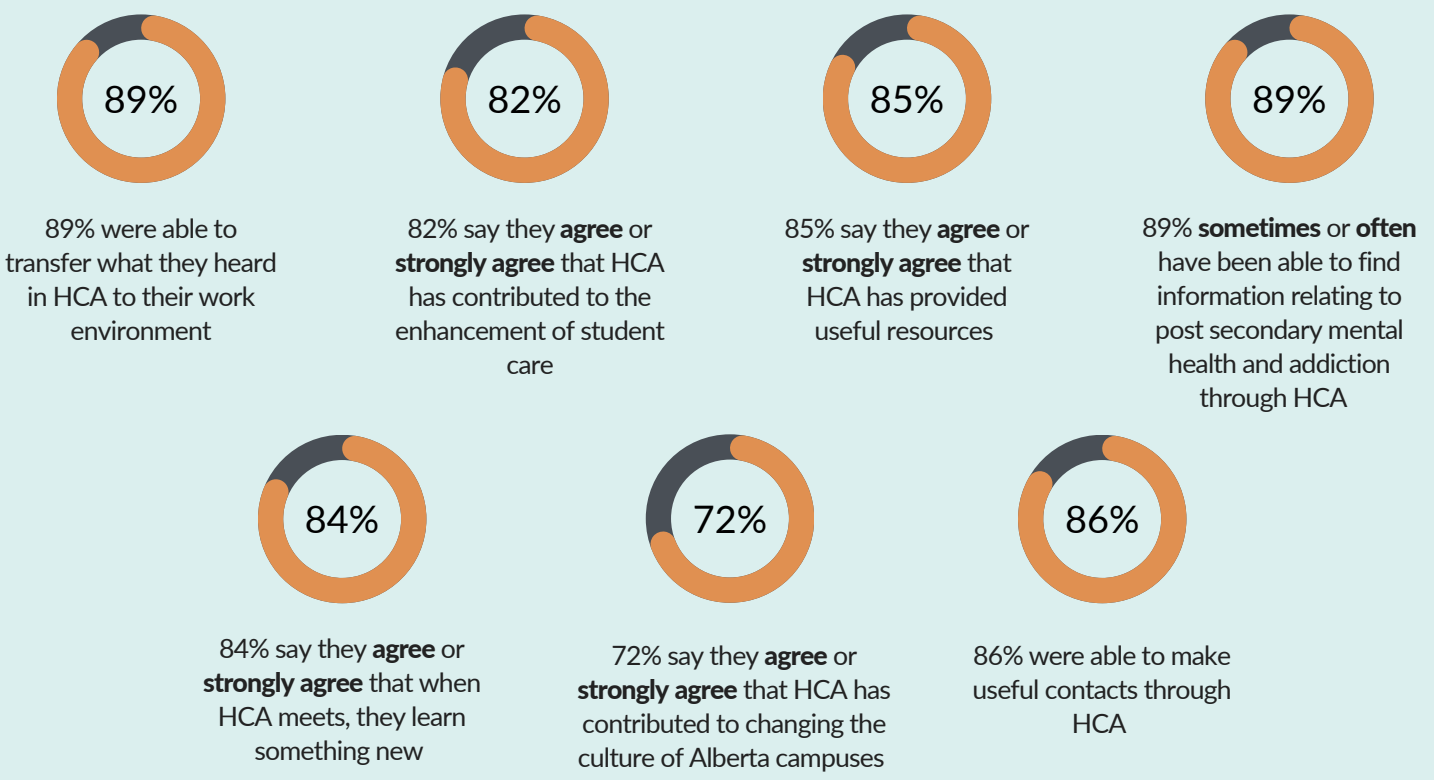


HCA COMMUNITY IMPACT

Results of the HCA 2024 Community Impact Survey

In June 2024, we shared the HCA Impact Survey, asking the Healthy Campus Alberta community of practice how being engaged with HCA had impacted them. A total of 40 participants responded. THE HCA ACTIVITIES YOU HAVE FOUND MOST MEANINGFUL.

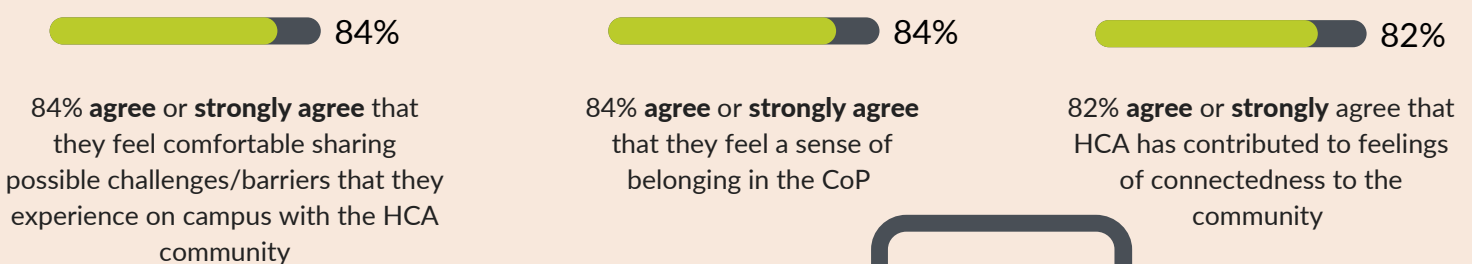


Word cloud represents most commonly mentioned meaningful HCA activities.
